



## Aleda Rovenstine

May 19, 1915 - September 25, 2014

Aleda Claire Rovenstine died Thursday, September 25, 2014, at the age of 99.

On May 19, 1915 in Ft. Sumner, NM, she was born Aleda Claire Warmerdam to parents John and Nellie (Marshall) Warmerdam. In May 1937, she married John Rovenstine at the Pilgrim Holiness Church in Hutchison, KS. She served alongside John at various churches throughout Kansas, before retiring in Bartlesville, OK, and joining Bartlesville First Wesleyan Church. Throughout her life, she enjoyed spending time with her family, sewing, playing the piano and singing hymns, upholstering furniture, camping, painting, and doing various crafts and projects to keep her busy.
