Alice Valera Davis, 80, of Bartlesville, died Monday in Nowata, OK.

Alice was born the daughter of JW and May Bell (Morris) Crittendon on August 2, 1934, in Wetumka, OK. The family worked on the pipelines and moved frequently to follow the work. Alice graduated from high school in Great Bend, KS, one of the many places her family lived at for a time.
