Amelia Ann Housby, 64, of Copan, passed away after a graceful and dignified fight with cancer in the early morning hours of Tuesday, March 22, 2022, wrapped in the love of her two children, Patrick and Sarah.

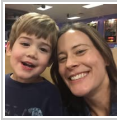
