Andy Russell Payne, 68, of Bartlesville died Tuesday February 10, 2015 in Bartlesville.

Andy was born the son of Eugene Russel and Marjorie Reese (Clark) Payne on October 31, 1946 in San Pedro, CA. His father was a union pipe fitter and the family moved from job to job while he was growing up. Andy enlisted in the United States Navy at the age of Seventeen and was stationed at Port Hyeneme from 1963-1966. Andy was united in marriage with Pamela Male on November 29, 1969 in Morris, IL. They made their home wherever the work was since he followed in his father's footsteps as a union pipefitter for 43 years. He was a member of the International brotherhood of pipe fitters, sprinkler fitters and Plumbers. In 2005 Andy and Pamela moved to Bartlesville to be nearer their children.

Andy had many passions in life mostly centering around Pamela and the kids. He loved outdoor activities such as fishing and hog hunting.
