Rebecca Lura Arnett, 69, of Bartlesville, died Wednesday in Bartlesville surrounded by her loving family.

Becky was born the daughter of Benjamin and Ollie Bell (Estes) Bailey on February 19, 1952 in Flippin, AR. The family lived in rural Arkansas before moving to Bartlesville, OK, when she was an infant. Becky attended Bartlesville schools, graduating from Sooner High in 1970.

At the beginning of her life's love story, Becky was dating Larry's friend when they first met, but sometime later she became available and Larry was ready. Even though they attended different high schools, Becky and Larry were high school sweethearts. Just a few months after their graduations, they united in marriage on October 30, 1970 and went on to enjoy 51 years of loving marriage.
