Billie Jean Davis, 78, of Bartlesville, triumphantly entered the gates of heaven on Sunday, December 28, 2025, surrounded by the love of her family.

Billie was born February 4, 1947, in Barnsdall, Oklahoma, to William Warren and Erma Jean (Hodgson) Ryan. She grew up in Barnsdall, graduating from Barnsdall High School in 1965. After high school, Billie was employed with Phillips Petroleum Company for about seven years.

She met the love of her life, Louis M. Davis Jr., through a school friend. They were married on April 5, 1969, in Bartlesville. Once they started their family, Billie was a stay-at-home mother. After her children were in school, she started working as a special education teacher's assistant at Dewey Public Schools. 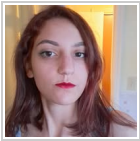
