Billy “Bill” Ray Shambles, 72, of Bartlesville, passed away on Monday, November 11, 2024.

Bill was born December 4, 1951, in Bell Gardens, California, to Flora Jane (McHargue) and Robert Lee Shambles Sr. Bill graduated from Barnsdall High School in 1970 and then completed the drafting program at Tri County Technology Center.
