Billy C. Yearout, 90, of Bartlesville, died Saturday in Tulsa.

Billy was born the son of John Joseph and Mamie Arlene (Whaling) Yearout on February 7, 1928, in Osage County. He grew up in a log cabin that was located next door to the Labadie School in Osage County. Once his schooling was completed Billy went to work for Harry Miller, taking care of and exercising his race horses.
