Bo smiled and laughed almost constantly. He enjoyed simple pleasures from video gaming to playing with minnows (far more than fishing!). He liked being active and on-the-go – Bo rode horses and participated in Special Olympics track and field. Bo loved spending time with family and looked forward to taking trips to Branson and Six Flags. He found fun in everyday stuff and was a huge fan of IHOP and Sonic chili dogs. He couldn't drive by one without stopping.

Bo was the sweetest young man. He's been through numerous surgeries and always maintained an amazing attitude. His body was genetically missing a chromosome, but his life was spiritually abundant.

One major facial surgery at Dallas Children's Hospital stands out. Bo was in the ICU for several days and his aunt Carol remembers it being very intense.

Then one day when he woke up, he pointed to different areas of the room and each time he made the sign language for Angel and waved bye, several times over. We knew at that very moment he was going to be ok. You see, God put his angels in charge over Bo. Then God used Bo signing to show us He is here with us. Just like He is here with us today!

God blessed us through this little kind man who always had a hug for you. Without a shadow of doubt Bo is with the Lord today, laughing, praising, and talking! His deaf ears have been opened. What a joyous day!

Bo is survived by his dad Dale Scott and second father Jerry Cook, and blessed by many siblings Brandon (and Mindy) Cranor, Russell Cranor, Amber Scott, Cody (and Erika) Scott, Chad (and Audra) Scott, Carrie Scott, Kelly Cook, Vern Cook, Reece Gonzales, Nadia (and Blake) Gonzalez-Jones, Andrew Gonzalez and Bianco Badillo, and step grandmother Caroline Scott. 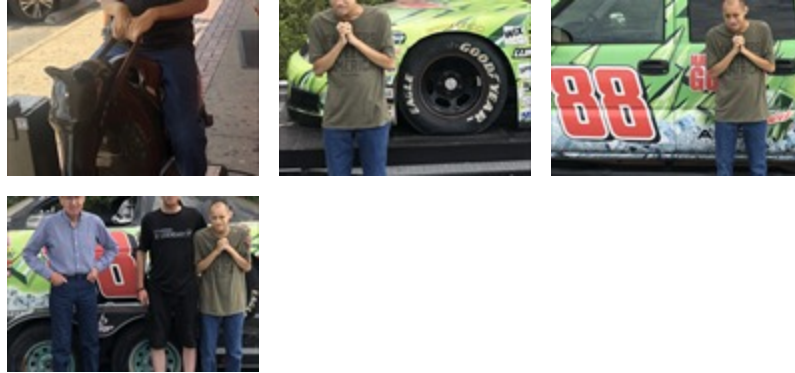
