Boaz was a “daddy’s boy” and was always the first one to greet his dad after work. He would not sit with anyone but Zac. He also loved his brothers and would crawl all over them on the couch. His brothers did not mind because they adored him. Bo loved being outside and enjoyed puzzle boxes. He also loved playing with his dogs. He was the best baby, and he was so very happy.

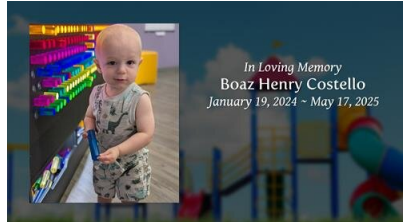
