Bobbi Jo Blum, 33, with her loving family by her side, went home to be with her Heavenly Father on Tuesday morning.

Bobbi Jo Blum was born the first child of Brad and Diana (Puckett) Turner on April 21, 1981, in Duncan, OK. When she was seven, the family moved to Jenks, OK, for a short while before moving to Bryant, AR, then to Bartlesville when she was 10. She attended Bartlesville schools graduating from Bartlesville High School in 1999. Bobbi loved to write stories and won a prize while in school. She also loved to ride horses. Gizmo was her first horse, followed by Donte, then she rescued Dewey and broke him to be a gentle riding horse. Bobbi attended University of Oklahoma for a few semesters. She returned home and worked for Mazzio's for five years.

Bobbi was united in marriage with Jacob Blum on February 10, 2010. During their courtship, both Jacob and Bobbi accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior and remained strong in their faith throughout Bobbi's long fight with cancer. Bobbi and Jacob celebrated their union with a reception on August 28, 2010, and a memorable honeymoon to Denver, CO. Most recently, Bobbi worked at Medicalodge of Dewey where she was passionate about making patients' lives brighter.

Bobbi deeply loved her two children Garrett and Gentry. She was a loving

mother and brought her family together to enjoy meals together. She was a faithful member of Tyro Christian Church in Kansas and active in many church activities. Most recently she joined "OHCE" Oklahoma Home and Community Education. Simple trips to town were always fun for the family as they experienced little adventures together. She was compassionate and always stood up for the underdog. She was also steadfast in character and willing to work hard for what she wanted. Most of all she was loved by her family and will be dearly missed.

Bobbi is survived by her husband Jacob Blum and two children Garrett and Gentry Blum of the home; parents Brad and Dianna Turner, one brother Travis Turner and Jennifer, maternal grandmother Alice Davis, all of of Bartlesville; paternal grandparents Doyle and Doris Turner of Salina, KS, and a host of family and friends.
