



## Bobby Ray Thomison Sr.

Lifetime Dewey resident, Bobby Ray Thomison Sr. was born May 6, 1938 in Dewey, Oklahoma to Leo George and Susie Audray (Boyd) Thomison. He departed this life on Tuesday, August 2, 2016 in Bartlesville, Oklahoma at the age of 78 years old.

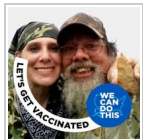
