Bradley Scott Magana, 50, of Bartlesville, passed away unexpectedly in the early hours of Sunday morning at Oologah Lake.

As a young man he worked the oil fields in numerous counties. Brad recently retired (due to ongoing health issues) from ABB after 10 years of employment in its manufacturing department.
