



## Burt Franklin King

October 13, 1935 - April 5, 2016

Burt Franklin “Buddy” King, 80, of Bartlesville, died Tuesday in Bartlesville.

Burt was born the son of Delton F. and Francis Ida (David) King on October 13, 1935, in Dewey. He attended both Dewey and Bartlesville schools. One of his first jobs was as a pin setter at the Phillips Petroleum Company bowling alley where he would set back the pins by hand after each bowler took their turn. Over the years Burt worked many different jobs including detailing cars at Oakley Pontiac and as a custodian at Central Junior High. He worked for more than 20 years and retired as a custodian with Phillips in 1997.

Burt - or “Buddy” as he was known to many - loved to visit and socialize with friends. He was an avid walker on his home treadmill where he must have logged thousands of miles. Burt loved the Lord and was active in his home church, New Hope Assembly of God in Dewey. He was easygoing and loved his family and friends.

Burt is survived by three brothers John T. King of Ochelata, Howard N. King and Jan of Cleveland, and David D. King and Phyllis of Bartlesville; three sisters, Ida Mae Munkirs of Bartlesville, Carmel Holeman and Dave of Bartlesville, and Delma Rhett and Denzel of Ramona. He is preceded in death by his parents and one sister Clara Jane Cooper.

Graveside services will be held 2 p.m. Friday, April 8, at the White Rose Cemetery, with Johnny Ray Jones officiating. Visitation will be on Thursday 12-8 and Friday 10-12.
