Carol Jean (Foust) Stockton, 77, of Bartlesville was called home to celebrate with her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ on May 1, 2025, at 9:35 p.m. after a long battle with cancer.

Carol Jean (Foust) Stockton was born March 10, 1948, in Morehouse, Missouri to Daniel Chester Kinder and Rosa Lee (Fowler) Kinder. On June 4, 1965, Carol married Jerry Leon Foust in Morehouse, where they started a family in southeast Missouri then soon after moved to west Texas. In 1974 they moved the family to Bartlesville, Oklahoma. Carol was a stay-at-home mother and cared for young children in the home for many years until she moved to Woolaroc Ranch in 1988. She began working at Woolaroc and became the secretary of the Museum where she visited with people from all over the world and eventually retired. While their marriage was a beautiful example of love and full of adventure, her first love went to be with Jesus in 2011. On January 9, 2013, Carol married Glen Edwin Stockton of Bartlesville, Oklahoma. She called him her “Krispy-Kreme” husband. She said if God was going to send her another man, he would have to be hot and sweet. Glen and Carol shared a beautiful love for each other, traveled together, and attended church activities, and she would often accompany Glen on his Ham radio club adventures. Carol was so blessed to love and to be loved by two incredible men.

In 2021, Carol was diagnosed with cancer and went into remission that fall. She took a celebration girls trip with her four daughters and made lasting memories full of tears, laughter, and joy. Her cancer returned in 2023. She fought hard. To know Carol, you knew she loved the Lord, she loved her family, she loved her friends, and she loved to laugh. Carol taught us all to be strong, to endure, and to finish well; but most of all she taught us to always “choose joy”.

Carol is survived by her husband, Glen Edwin Stockton of Bartlesville. Six daughters; Kim and husband Jim Scherman of Bartlesville; Jerrie Lynn and husband B.J. 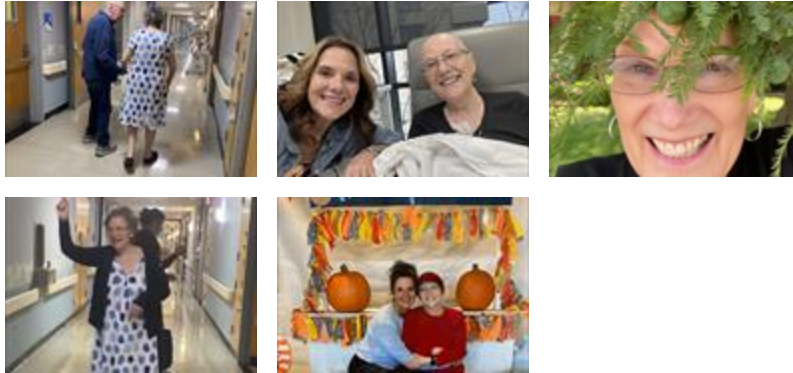

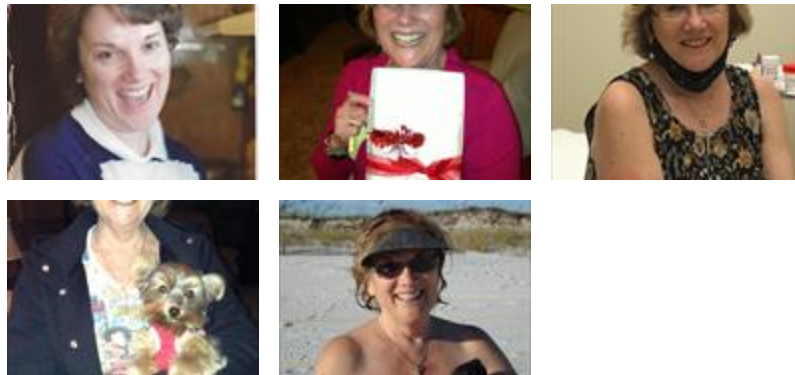
