Carol June Toney, 70, died Saturday in her Copan home surrounded by her loving family.

Carol was one of eight children born to Leo and Fawn (Brown) Dobbs on Oct. 26, 1947, in Dewey, OK. She was a lifelong area resident, attending Dewey schools with the Class of 1965. Carol worked 23 years for Oklahoma Beverage, which bottled Coca-Cola products, retiring when the plant moved to Tulsa in 1990. Carol was active with Dobbie's, her family's business in Dewey since 1982, and in 2015, she became the owner just one year after they celebrated their 60th anniversary. After five years of going together, Carol was united in marriage with Fred Toney on Feb. 19, 1997, in Miami, OK. They made their home west of Copan.

Carol loved her family and most recently cherished time spent with her great-grand babies. Shopping and visiting with friends along the way could turn into long adventures. She enjoyed watching old westerns on TV. Carol often said, "I've been blessed with the many good friends I've made over the years and lived the simple life". She will be dearly missed by her beloved family, friends and customers.
