Cassandra Ann Blount, 35, of Bartlesville, began her heavenly adventure on Tuesday, July 16, 2024.

Cassandra was born June 23, 1989, in Bartlesville, to Kent and Julie (Wastlund) Blount. She attended Bartlesville Public Schools, where she developed her deep love of music, singing, and performing arts. She was in the Bartlesville High School Band and enjoyed the choir program. She was so very talented and was happy to be a member of various Honors Choirs, including Circle the State with Song, District Honor Choir and multiple others. In her younger years, she was a member of the Possibility People Choir at Bartlesville's First Wesleyan Church. She also performed in several Children's Musical Theater productions through the years and with Bartlesville Theater Guild's "The King and I." Cassandra's talent with music eventually led her to becoming worship leader at Bartlesville First Church.

Always an adventurer at heart, Cassandra shared many outdoor adventures with her mother, family and dear friends. Her mother Julie was always a ready and willing "adventure buddy." They enjoyed numerous nights of camping, rockhounding, and kayaking, with special memories of kayaking during the eclipse, nighttime kayaking at Twin Bridges, and rockhounding at the Salt Plains and at the Ron Coleman Mine.
