Charles Alan Bailey, lifelong resident of Bartlesville, died Tuesday, November 13, 2012.

Alan was born September 18, 1958, to Dr. Charles Bailey and Nell Marie Thomas. He was a proud member of ROTC at Sooner High School. After graduating in 1976, he worked on the Copan Dam, then attended Wesleyan College. Alan worked for the Phillips Petroleum Co. on its seismograph crew for three years, from 1989 to 1992.

He liked working with his hands and working for himself. Alan was co-owner of an auto detail shop, and he was a self-employed tile layer and handyman for 13 years, from 1992 to 2005, until retiring early due to health reasons. Alan will be remembered for his loving heart and will be dearly missed.
