Darrel Piepergerdes, age 92, Phillips retiree and longtime resident of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, died Friday April 14, 2017.

Darrel E. Piepergerdes was born in Stewartsville, Missouri, to Hattie and Earl Piepergerdes on October 22, 1924. During World War II, he served in the United States Army in the European Theatre of operations. Following his honorable discharge, he returned to his employment with Phillips Petroleum Company in Kansas City, Missouri. On April 19, 1947, he was married to the love of his life Jean Gray in Kansas City. In 1964, he was transferred to Bartlesville with Phillips Petroleum where he continued his employment until retiring in 1985. In retirement, Darrel and Jean traveled in the US for several years in their RV, walking in the mall and spending time together. They enjoyed 60 years of loving marriage and they truly enjoyed each other.

Survivors include his two sons, Dale Piepergerdes of Mission, Kansas, and Dean Piepergerdes of Bartlesville; and one brother Lawrence Piepergerdes of Independence, Missouri. His beloved wife Jean preceded him in death in 2006 and one sister Kathleen Newcom.

Mr. Piepergerdes was a member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church. Graveside services will be held at Johnson County Memorial Gardens, Overland Park, Kansas on Wednesday April 19 at 11 am. Visitation will be held Monday and
