Dolores Ann Stanberry, longtime area resident, died Wednesday, January 10, 2024, in Bartlesville. The loving wife and mother was 88 when she received her eternal reward in Heaven.

Dolores was born the oldest daughter of Loyce and Ethel (Lewis) Hardy on January 28, 1935, in Denison, TX. She was the oldest sibling so she was blessed with quality time spent with her Aunt Geneva and Uncle Bud. She loved them dearly. Once retired, Bugs and Dolores spent many winters in south Texas escaping the chill of Oklahoma winter. Dolores loved to travel and Bugs went along, taking several cruises and visiting Australia, Switzerland, Germany to name a few. She was a wonderful mother, Nana, and Nana2. She

enjoyed playing cards, games and attending the grandkids/great grandkids many activities. Dolores loved to work in her backyard and had prettiest flower garden around! She loved to bake, watch Hallmark movies and cheer for the Kansas City Chiefs. She often said she was blessed with two great sons-in-law.
