Dorothy Jean Crouch, 89, lifelong Dewey Oklahoma resident, passed away Saturday April 11, 2020, in her hometown.

Dorothy was born on April 20, 1930 to Von and Roxie (Easley) Coke. She was raised in Dewey and graduated from Dewey High School in 1949. She began working at Lemons Grocery Store until she began working for Phillips Petroleum Co. in 1953, where she started as a part-time elevator operator before being promoted to a full-time key punch operator working on the company's data entry. She met James "Tom" Ray Crouch during one of the Saturday night dances. They were married on May 5, 1962, in Bartlesville, OK, but made their home in Dewey where they raised three wonderful daughters.
