



## Ellen May Solomon

February 22, 1932 - December 7, 2020

Ellen May (Graham) Raue Williams Solomon of Ochelata died Monday in Ochelata. She was 88 when she departed this earthly life on December 7, 2020, after a lifetime of caring for others and loving her children and large extended family.

Ellen was born February 22, 1932, to Levi and May (Kerr) Graham in Omaha, Nebraska. She graduated from Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) school in 1976 and later graduated Administrator school in 1986.
