July 11, 1937 - August 25, 2023

Everett Tweed Swanson Sr., 86, of Dewey, passed away on Friday, August 25, 2023, at his home in rural Dewey.

Everett was born July 11, 1937, in Tallant, OK, to Bart and Ludie (Soward) Swanson. He attended Nelagoney, OK, schools and graduated in 1956. Soon after high school, he joined the U.S. Army, having basic training in El Paso, TX, and then went to Ft. Sill before serving overseas in Germany. Following his honorable discharge, Everett worked at Bareco Wax Plant in Barnsdall for 11 years.

While on leave during his service, Everett and an Army buddy of his, Tommy, drove to Blanchard, OK. Everett was visiting his aunt and uncle, who had a daughter Mary Sue. It was through Mary Sue that Everett met and fell in love with his soulmate, Martha Ellen Crowley. Fate stepped in when Mary Sue also found love in Everett's Army buddy, Tommy.

Everett and Martha were married on October 10, 1958, in Blanchard, OK, after he returned home from Germany. To this union four sons were born, Glenn, Everette Jr., Eric, and Larry.

Everett was employed with Cities Service in January 1970 and stayed there until his retirement in December 1997.

His hobbies include welding, woodworking, and gardening. He was a skilled craftsman and used his talent to make things for others, including barbecue grills. He never sold them; he made them as gifts. He had a generous, big heart. Everett and Martha loved traveling in their travel trailer.

He loved the Lord and witnessed to others to the end. They have been members of the Wann Baptist Church for the past 7-8 years and before that time were members of the Independence Southern Baptist Church.

Everett adored his grandchildren and his life revolved around them. He loved his family and will be dearly missed!

Survivors include his loving wife of 64 years, Martha; his four sons, Glenn and Sharon Swanson, Everette Swanson Jr., Eric Swanson, and Larry and Christy Swanson; a sister, Ernestine Montgomery; a brother, Loyal Swanson; seven grandchildren, Shelby Swanson, Sarah Walter, Dakota Swanson, Garrett Swanson, Madison Swanson, Bryce Swanson, and Logan Swanson; and two great-grandchildren, Sawyer and Harper Swanson.
