Freddie "Fred" Eugene Toney, 83, a lifelong resident of Copan, joined his beloved wife Carol June Toney in heaven on Monday, October 21, 2024.

Fred was born June 27, 1941, in Copan, OK, to Earl Edward and Liza Faye (Forrester) Toney. He attended Copan schools and graduated from Copan High School in 1959. A hardworking entrepreneur, Fred owned and operated several businesses throughout his life. He owned T & H Electrical Heating and Air and did air-conditioning repair work for 10 years. He was also an owner and operator of H & T Tank Truck, and owned Copan Marine from 1990-2005. In 2007 he purchased Cove Bait and Tackle and then in May 2015 he purchased Dobbie's Bar. Fred never retired and continued working his entire life.
