Harold Lowry passed away Friday, November 28, 2014.

He married Darlene Waddell on June 13, 1978 in Miami, OK. Harold dedicated over 31 years of service to Philips Petroleum Co. retiring as a gasoline coordinator. He then worked for WalMart before retiring in 2002. Harold served his country with distinction as a member of the Field Artillery Support Group during his twelve years in the U.S. Army. He also served his community by being the Commander of the American Legion Post #105 for two terms, a member of the Masonic Lodge in Dewey and a member of REACT. REACT was a local community service organization that assisted with rescues during/after local and national disasters. He also assisted in bringing the American Legion Baseball World Series to Bartlesville as well as acting as president of Kiddie Park for four years. He was a member of the Oldies & Goodies Car Club and was awarded the Jim Gillie Outstanding

Citizen award for his service to the people of Bartlesville.

Harold is survived by his wife Darlene of the family home in Dewey. Three sons: Greg Martin Lowry and wife LaGina of Tulsa, John Paul Lowry and Alicia Fair of Tulsa, Patrick Francis Lowry and wife Kimberly of Bartlesville.
