



## Hazel "JoAnn" Spradlin

Hazel "JoAnn" (Moore) Spradlin went home to be with the Lord on Nov. 22, 2016, while at her home in Bartlesville, OK at the age of 79. She is also survived by one sister Lois Higgins of Princeton, MO, and Lois's sons Mark and David along with their families.
