Helen E. Sherrick, 88, of Bartlesville, died Wednesday, May 1, 2024, in Bartlesville.

Helen was born the daughter of Oren Emery and Sybil Lorraine (Kees) Lowry on June 28, 1935, in Bartlesville. She was raised in Bartlesville with her seven siblings and graduated from College High School. She accepted Jesus Christ as her personal savior at a young age and was active in her home church, Bartlesville Assembly of God. Helen was united in marriage with Thomas Eugene Sherrick on July 26, 1951, and she joined him in San Diego, where he was stationed in the Navy. During his 20 years of active service (1949-1969), the family lived in a variety of places around the world. In 1969 they made their home in Bartlesville. After 67 years of loving marriage Thomas preceded her in death in 2019.

Helen and Thomas were active in the church where they were stationed. They sought out smaller churches and were active in the ministries of the church. At her home church, now Spirit Church, she was known as the cookie lady. She made all the cookies for the visitors' baskets. She was especially fond of her grandchildren. Her house was known as Camp Grandma and her motto was printed right on her mug, "Where NO is never Spoken." Helen cooked their favorite foods and together they would bake treats to share and enjoy. Most of all she was steadfast, immovable, absolutely reliant on the strength of the

Holy Spirit and His guidance.

Helen is survived by her children, David Sherrick, Steve Sherrick and Tim (Jolett) Sherrick; siblings, Lester Lowry and Sue Lowry (Harold) Wootton; grandchildren, Stephanie Sherrick, Samantha Anderson, Drew Sherrick, Olivia Sherrick and Wyatt Sherrick; and a host of other family and friends. She is preceded in death by her parents; husband; grandson, Richard Sherrick; and siblings, Nadine Garrett, Doris Louise Lowry, Vernon Lowry, Orene Parker and Richard Lowry.
