



Mr. Jack Chester Mull

February 21, 1930 - September 23, 2014

Jack Chester Mull, 84, of Copan, died Tuesday morning in Dewey.

Jack was born the son of Henry and Irene Mull on February 21, 1930, in Wayside, KS. The family moved to Caney where Jack graduated from Caney High School in 1948. He was inducted into the U.S. Navy and served on the USS Askari (ARL-30) until his honorable discharge in 1952. Jack's love of playing baseball was instrumental in him starting his career with Cities Service Oil Company in 1953 where he played on the company team. Jack met the love of his life June Haugh while she was working with Cities Service and they were united in marriage on May 9, 1959. Jack was transferred with Citis Service to the Tulsa office in 1969 and transitioned to Occidental Petroleum before retiring after 32 years of service in 1985. Jack and June moved back to the land in Copan that they had been readying for a new home to be built in 1999.

Jack loved to play many sports including basketball, football, and baseball and he was an avid Yankees fan. He also supported the Copan High School Girls softball team for many years, oftentimes helping to ready the field for home games. Jack and June volunteered at the Delaware Pow Wow, working with his brother and sister-in-law Andy and Barbara Davis. Jack was a member of the Masonic Lodge and was also a Shriner Clown. His grandfather Albert Nolte was his biggest influence in life. Jack will be dearly missed.

Jack is survived by his wife June Mull of Dewey; his son Gary Mull and Jamie of Tulsa; one step grandson Zeke Starks of Tulsa; one sister Peggy Obermier of Independence, KS; three nephews, Kent Obermier, John Davis and David Davis; and one niece Candy Obermier. He is preceded in death by his parents.

Funeral services will be held 2 p.m. on Friday, September 26, 2014, at the Chapel of the Davis Family Funeral Home with Chaplin Mike McDougan officiating. Interment will follow in the Dewey Cemetery, with full military honors provided by the James T. Teel American Legion Post 105 Honor Guard.
