Jackie Lee Kiado, 73, of Dewey, died Wednesday in Dewey. Yearly trips to Eureka Springs with her girls were a highlight with the best part being the drive back and forth. Just recently Jackie

requested one last trip to visit her brother's house on the Gulf Coast with the girls and so much fun was had playing games and laughing. The annual family reunion was sure to happen with Jackie organizing all the details every year. She will be remembered for her love of Elvis, Mickey Mouse and her homemade stuffing at Thanksgiving. Most of all Jackie loved her family and her grandchildren, and she loved being around, in each of their lives. She was the matriarch and everyone looked up to her.
