



## Jackie Lee Sayles

February 24, 1958 - July 10, 2022

Jackie Lee Sayles, 64, of Vinita, died Sunday in Bartlesville. He will be mourned with sorrow on earth but he's now rejoicing with his Heavenly Father.

Jackie was born the second oldest son of Buel Clettis and Queenester Clara (Brown) Sayles on February 24, 1958, in Bartlesville. He was raised in Dewey, alongside his siblings and many friends. Jackie loved sports and was active in track, pole vaulting and football at Dewey Schools. During this time he earned the nickname of Rabbit for his spryness and high jumps.

After graduating in 1977, Jackie went to work for the City of Dewey for many years, before moving to Vinita to be closer to his cousin Sherman. For the past 16 years he's worked as a custodian at the downtown Vinita McDonald's and later as a cook at a different location.

Jackie loved to go fishing and enjoyed drinking coffee. His favorite football teams were the Dallas Cowboys and the Washington Redskins (now the Washington Commanders). When not working and relaxing at home, he liked reading westerns and his bible daily. Jackie was loved dearly and will be missed.
