James William Snook, 75, of Copan, went home to meet the Lord on Monday, May 8, 2023, in Bartlesville, surrounded by loved ones.

James, or Butch as his family called him, was born on April 19, 1948, in Lewistown, Pennsylvania to James Russel Snook and Maudie May Long. He was raised in Pennsylvania, and at one point the family lived in Germany, an experience he fondly remembered. His mother Maudie Brown later united in marriage with a loving father figure, Jack Long, and the family settled in Bartlesville.

James was first introduced to the love of his life, Delora Tuttle, by her sister Ruby. James and Delora were united in marriage on July 17, 1971, at Copan United Methodist Church and made their home in Bartlesville. To this union two boys were born, James and John. They moved to Copan in 1986, and the family enjoyed fishing, camping and time spent water skiing.

James worked more than 40 years as a truck driver, delivering and transporting materials for Bartlesville Redi Mix. His sons joined the team alongside him until James' retirement. The boys continue on in his place.
