James (Jim) Goins, 73, of Bartlesville died suddenly Sunday.

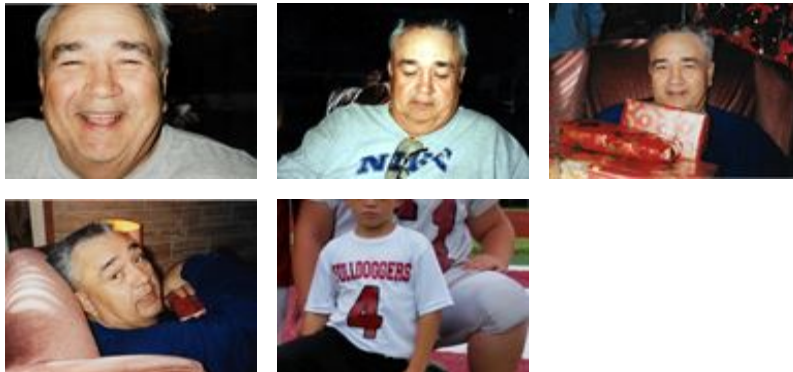
