Dad, can u see me? Do u look over me? There is so many questions I want to ask u like, r u proud of me?

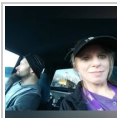
I hope everyone that knows him doesn't forget about him. Thank u guys for all the prayers and the reach outs. Please don't forget about my dad. Love u all.

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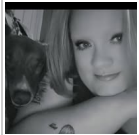

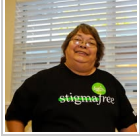
