Jerry Anson Freeman of Bartlesville was 93 when he died Sunday, September 18th in Bartlesville. He joins his beloved wife and Christ his Savior in heaven.

Jerry was born the son of Glen Anson and Laura Elizabeth (Miller) Freeman on December 15, 1928, in Parsons, KS. He was raised and educated in Parsons. Somewhere along the way, he met Kathleen Eichhorn through mutual friends and they quickly fell in love. The young couple tied the love knot on June 22, 1952 and went on to enjoy 66 years of loving marriage.

During the Korean Conflict, Jerry served his nation and was stationed at the Pentagon in Washington, D.C. Once honorably discharged he furthered his education at Pitt State and graduated with a degree in accounting. They moved to Bartlesville for his 25 plus year career at Phillips Petroleum Co. Kathleen preceded him in death on March 15, 2018.

From a young age, Jerry had artistic talent and taught himself to play the piano. He would oftentimes play for family and friends, most recently at the foyer in Tallgrass Estates to entertain his fellow residents. Jerry enjoyed gardening, taking care of his yard and sitting on his porch swing. He was also exceptional at painting and photography. He especially enjoyed helping Kathleen by carving and fabricating wood bases for the sculptures she created. Together they enjoyed eating out, and she was famous for swinging

by Murphy's and bringing home dinner. Jerry loved the Lord and was a longtime member of Bartlesville First Church.

Jerry is survived by his daughter Debbie Freeman and her children, Colin, Jean, James and Brian Gasal. He was preceded in death by his wife Kathleen and his parents.
