Jess L. McCorkle, 69, of Dewey, joined his Lord and Savior in heaven on Monday, October 10, 2022.

Jess was born December 17, 1952, in Topeka, Kansas, to Paul and Edith Ann (Myers) McCorkle. He attended college in McCook, Nebraska, and earned his associate degree in business. He also graduated from the police academy in Grand Island, Nebraska.

In 1974 in Kearney, Nebraska, Jess met the love of his life Cherie Livingston on a blind date, which was initiated through their lifelong friends, Sherry and Don Purvis. The couple fell head over heels for each other and married on May 31, 1975, in Hayes Center, Nebraska. The couple moved to Bartlesville in 1975 and Cherie attended what was then called Bartlesville Wesleyan College (now Oklahoma Wesleyan University).
