John Robert “Johnny” Jones, 87, longtime Bartlesville resident, passed away at Bartlesville Care Center on Wednesday September 21, 2011.

Graveside services for Mr. Jones will be held 10am Monday in the Dewey Cemetery. Rev Curt Meade will be the officiant. Visitation for Mr. Jones will be held at the Davis Family Funeral Home on Sunday from 12pm – 8pm. Arrangements are under the direction of the Davis Family Funeral Home.

Johnny Jones was born on August 23, 1924 in Bartlesville and during his infancy, the Jones family moved to Prescott, Mo. where he was reared and received his education in the Prescott country school.
