He loved joking and playing games with family and friends. Joe loved texting to family and friends, sending funny videos, emoji's and things about angels. He was very nosey, he would aggravate Georgetta by asking where you are going, who are you going with, when you will be back and what time, or text her what we are eating and tell her his order. Joe fought a good fight, as well as most of you know he should have died at 33, and again 10 years later his second heart attack. The doctors said three years ago he wouldn't make it, but Joe wasn't ready, and as everyone knows never count Joe out. When it came to his time, he gave no warning, he went quickly and peacefully, went to sleep and didn't wake up. Dad, brother, Papa Joe, Uncle Joe and Sloppy Joe we love you and you will be greatly missed. Joe finished his race well.
