It is with great sadness that the family of Joycelyn Jane (Teehee) Brewster announce her passing on September 24, 2024, at her home in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

Joycelyn (known as Jane) was born May 24, 1935, to Alfred Lee Teehee Sr. and Havil Elizabeth (Harpe) Teehee in Sedan, Kansas. Jane graduated from Peru High School as valedictorian in 1953. She married Willard C. (Bud) Brewster Jr. on November 4, 1953. From this union five children were born. Their names are Monnie K. Brewster, Lonnie K. Brewster, Gail A. Swaim, Peggy J. Mumma and Tony R. Brewster.

Jane was a homemaker and raised her family in the Sedan and Peru area. Later, Bud and Jane retired, making their home in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

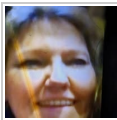
