Judy Kay Clifford, 81, of Bartlesville, passed away on Wednesday, June 19, 2024, in Tulsa.

Judy was born February 19, 1943, in Cedarvale, Kansas, to Earl Sanders and Catherine (Hills) Mills. She graduated in 1961 from Caney, Kansas, High School.
