Kathryn Elaine Crupper, 95, of Bartlesville, died Thursday in Bartlesville, at home with her family.

Kathryn “Elaine” was born the daughter of William Walter and Etta Pearl (Diediker) Rigney on Aug. 26, 1923, in Paola, KS. Elaine was raised in the Paola area and in her teen years the family moved to Fairfax, OK, where she continued her education, participated in band and worked at the Tall Chief (Movie) Theatre.
