Keli Lynn Goff (Fox), 56, was born December 7, 1969, in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, to Raymond and Louise Fox. She passed away surrounded by those who loved her on March 3, 2026.

Keli grew up in Dewey, Oklahoma, where she attended school, participated in stage choir, and graduated in 1989. Growing up, she loved playing basketball and spending time with her little sister, listening to music and watching movies.
