She could be counted on when needed. She was ALWAYS there. She was present at the NICU after the birth of her premature grandchildren and at the hospital when her grandchildren were injured.

While her son Jason was deployed overseas, Leatha sent packages to him to bless the impoverished children in his deployment region. She also sent many care packages to him throughout his numerous deployments. She continued sending care packages to her grandson Heath while he was deployed. Many military personnel enjoyed her gifts.

Leatha absolutely loved the Christmas and Thanksgiving holidays. She always had a wall of Christmas stockings. Each person's stocking was different. She collected Santa Claus figurines, and she enjoyed searching for new ones. Every room in her house would be decorated with a Christmas tree.

Leatha's loving children have many fond memories of their mother, including a funny time when she got a green apple Jolly Rancher stuck in her teeth right after having dental surgery. She was afraid of scorpions, and Jason used that knowledge to keep Leatha out of his bedroom as a teenager by stationing a scorpion ball at the door of his bedroom. So many memories richly bless this large family.
