Marcia Ann Munkirs, age 76, peacefully passed away Sunday, January 19th, 2025, in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

Marcia was born August 15, 1948 to Wendell and Una Belle Lein in Gordon, Nebraska. Marcia loved growing up on her family farm in Gordon. She graduated from Gordon High School in 1967 and moved to Rapid City for business school. After finishing school, she moved to Kansas City to work for Phillips.
