Margaret Ann Hollenbeck, 65, went home to her Heavenly Father, August 13, 2016 from Tulsa, Oklahoma. Margaret was born at Wheaton, Mo. on August 10, 1951, one of 11 children to Burness Albert “Cap” and Mary Louise “Dolly” Dishon Day. She graduated from Independence Bible School, Independence, Kansas in May, 1969 and six months later on Nov. 21 married the love of her life, Rick Hollenbeck.
