Kaye took a break to care for her mother and most recently went to work at Braum's. Little did Kaye know that when she bought her home in Dewey the neighbor across the street would be Bob Turner. They hit it off and were married, welcoming one son into their lives, Isaac. They eventually realized they were better off as best friends and remained neighbors.

Kaye loved to garden and oftentimes rescued plants that looked tired or

scraggly and brought them back to life, by planting them in her yard or giving them to friends. She was a Master Gardener and volunteered countless hours of her time planting and caring for the flowers at both the Dewey and Bartlesville public libraries, and with her fellow gardeners at the Bartlesville Garden Club.

She was active in her son's life, and they enjoyed fishing and hanging out together, whether indoors immersed in games and movies or outdoors enjoying fresh air and sunshine. She loved the Lord and was a member of the New Hope Indian United Methodist Church where she enjoyed volunteering for its monthly Indian Taco dinner fundraisers. Kaye was loving and kind to everyone, and they loved her back. She made time to pray for them all.

Kaye is survived by her son, Isaac Turner; mother, Ann Hasting; sister, Diana Avery; one half-sister, Naomi Avery; five half-brothers, Ben Avery, Kevin Avery, David Crawford, Matt Avery, and Chet Avery; ex-husband and best friend, Bob Turner; and many nieces and nephews.
