



## Niles Sims

April 9, 1931 - August 24, 2018

David 'Niles' Sims, 87, of Lee's Summit, Missouri, passed away peacefully on August 24, 2018, at Summit Pointe Health Facility.

Niles was born on April 9, 1931, in Jefferson City, Missouri, to William Tell Sims and Mary Theodocia Roach. Niles joined the U.S. Navy December 28, 1950, and was in the Korean War. He served as a store keeper on the USS Calvert and was honorably discharged on November 3, 1954. He then attended Central Missouri College in Warrensburg, MO, and graduated with a business degree.

On December 1, 1956, in Sedalia, MO, Niles married his eternal companion Deloris Ann Furnell. After being hired as a computer operator with Phillips Petroleum Co. in March 1960, they made their home in Bartlesville, Oklahoma for the majority of their lives. He retired from Phillips after 36 years of dedicated service.

He was an active member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, serving in numerous callings. Niles was well known for being the church softball coach where he led the team to 1st and 2nd place seasons. Even after retirement he continued to contribute to the community by driving for Grisham's Eye Associates and City Ride - making friends wherever he went.

Niles was preceded in death by his wife of 47 years, Deloris; his parents, William and Mary (Dottie) Sims; and his brother Jerry Sims. He is survived by his three children: son David and his wife Lesta Sims of Lee's Summit, MO, daughter, Lori and her husband Jeff Hartzfeld of Layton, Utah, and daughter Angela and her husband Todd McClintock of Bartlesville OK; 10 grandchildren; nine great grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.

Niles will be remembered for his big smile, huge laugh and long hugs.

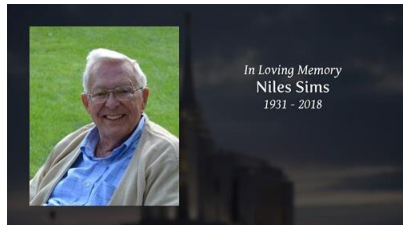
