



## Mrs. Norma Mae Brurud

April 23, 1926 - June 21, 2014

Norma Mae Brurud passed into life eternal at 7:30 a.m. Saturday while at the Journey Home in Bartlesville.

Norma was born April 23, 1926, to Barton and Ora Galagar in Avant, OK. She completed grade school and high school in Avant and then attended Business College in Bartlesville.

She married Don Brurud on Christmas Eve (Dec. 24) of 1948, at the First Methodist Church in Bartlesville. They made their home in Bartlesville where they were both employed at Phillips Petroleum Co. Norma later terminated her employment with Phillips to stay home and raise their two sons, Clark and Brian up to the age when they enrolled in school. She then returned to the workforce and was employed by Jane Phillips Hospital in the business office. She worked there for 15 years before retiring.

Norma was a devoted wife and a loving mother and grandmother. She was a wonderful cook and homemaker. She loved life and staying active. She was a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church.

Surviving Norma are her loving husband Don of the home; sons Clark and Brian; and her beloved granddaughters (Brian's children) Bailey Brurud and Mallory Brurud; as well as two brothers Floyd Galagar and his wife Carol of

Amarillo, TX, and Robert "Bob" Galagar and his wife Geneva of Muskogee, OK. Preceding Norma in death were her parents, one sister Peggy Jane Lawson and one brother William "Bill" C. Galagar.
