Patrick "Chuck" Charles Ellis, 78, of Dewey, Oklahoma, passed away on Thursday, March 23, 2023, at his home.

Chuck was born August 29, 1944, in Amarillo, Texas, to William "Bill" and Ethel (Schreck) Ellis. After Bill's death, Ethel married Eugene Franks and Chuck gained a loving stepfather. 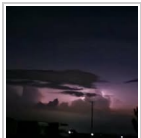

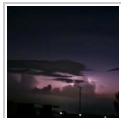

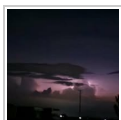
