Patrick Robert Clingen, 39, formerly of Bartlesville, died Tuesday in Burkburnett, TX.

Patrick was born the son of Robert James Clingen and Debra Jean (Ketchum) Minter on April 18, 1978, in Claremore, OK. He was raised in Bartlesville, attending Wesleyan Christian School through 8th grade then transferring to Dewey High School where he graduated with the Class of 1997. While in school Patrick was on the basketball and track teams. He furthered his education at Oklahoma Baptist University where he was a walk-on player for their basketball team. Patrick decided to pursue a career as a first responder and transferred to Missouri Southern University in Joplin where he earned his paramedic certification.
