



Phillip Joe Fitzsimmons

Phillip Joe Fitzsimmons, 86, of rural Wann, went to his heavenly home on Friday, April 26, 2024, in Bartlesville.

Phillip was born April 3, 1938, in Tucson, Arizona, to Cecil Phillip and Nanny Leona (Brink) Fitzsimmons. He grew up on the family farm and graduated from Wann High School. Phillip earned his Bachelor of Science degree at Oklahoma State University and shortly after that started working at a dairy in Oklahoma City. He returned to the Wann area in 1966 and became employed at Phillips Petroleum as a technician at the research island. He inherited his uncle's Cherokee allotment and raised his family there.

Phillip married Estle Theodoria Fitzsimmons on March 11, 1960, and to this union five children were born. Estle preceded him in death in 1985. He later married Leota Faye Fitzsimmons on April 27, 1986, and Phillip gained two wonderful stepchildren. Leota passed away in 2014.

Phillip was a member of the Lions Club for many years. He was also a member of the Dewey First Christian Church, where he served as a deacon and drove the bus for years.

Phillip was a hard worker and a strong, Christian father. He taught his children the value of working hard. He loved farming and was often seen with a smile

on his face even while doing the hardest of jobs on the farm.

Family was everything to Phillip and he was always active in his children's and grandchildren's lives. He was a caring, supportive father. He enjoyed hosting large family get-togethers, and he loved giving the children hayrides and hosting bonfires.

Phillip is survived by his seven children, Marsha Wheat and husband Bryan, Phillip Fitzsimmons Jr. and wife Diane, Renae Barnett and husband Royce Sr., Daniel Fitzsimmons and wife Kari, Timothy Fitzsimmons and wife Denè, Sydney Askrens, and Lawrence Finkenbinder. He is also survived by 22 grandchildren and 49 great-grandchildren. Phillip was preceded in death by his first wife, Estle Fitzsimmons; his second wife, Leota Fitzsimmons; and his parents, Cecil and Leona (Brink) Fitzsimmons.

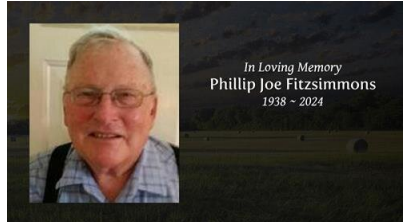
